Registration

- Adults can sign up by showing their valid personal ID or visa with an official proof of legal residence.
- For children and adolescents under 16 years, the registration must be signed by their legal representative.

The registration forms can be obtained in the public library. You can also request a library card online under www.stadtbibliothek-oldenburg.de.

Library card

- The library card is valid in all branches of the Public Library Oldenburg.
- Your library card is not transferable.
- Please keep it secure to keep unauthorised people from borrowing materials under your name.
- Please keep us up to date about name and address changes and lost library cards.

Borrowing Library Material

- You can normally borrow media for a period of four weeks. Special lending periods apply to a few media. So please observe the return date printed on your due date slip.
- Each time you borrow media, please check their condition and completeness in advance.

Renew lending period

Basically, the lending period for borrowed media can be renewed up to three times. The following media are exempt from that regulation:

- Titles that were reserved from other clients
- bestsellers that incur a fee
- the current issues of magazines
- Christmas and Easter books (seasonal)

Materials can be renewed for free on site and online through our library catalogue's user function. A small fee is collected for processing other renewal requests.

Reservation

You can reserve media from the library system for a small fee. The media will be prepared for you at the desired place of issuance.

Library catalogue

The library catalogue can be accessed online and allows you to search for media in the inventory of all locations of the Public Library Oldenburg, including the offerings of the digital library (Onleihe and MUNZIGER ONLINE).

Customer account

You can use the following user functions of our library catalogue via the internet:

- Renew the library card
- Display and/or renew media
- Display reservations
- Display fees

Info Service

With our Info Service, you can obtain information from the library – quickly and directly – by SMS, or by email:

- Notifications about media that are ready to be picked up
- Reminder after the lending period is exceeded

Bestseller service

To reduce waiting time, we offer you the current books in the 'Spiegel bestseller list' in the Public Library in the PFL under special conditions.

Internet workstations

In our libraries, we offer PC workstations with internet access and Office programs (including Word, Excel, and Power-Point) for you to use at no charge. If you would like to take advantage of this offer, please present your valid library card. Printouts can be made for a small fee.

Onleihe

Digital media can be borrowed from the Public Library around the clock at no charge. The online offerings are diverse – besides novels and nonfiction as eBooks or audiobooks, there are eMagazines such as 'Der Spiegel', 'Stern', and ePapers such as 'Die Zeit' or 'taz'. In addition, an extensive range of free eLearning offerings is available.

TigerBooks

Reading for children is digitally supported with an app. 'TigerBooks' brings the stories of beloved children's book stars to smartphones and tablets. This free service is suited for children aged two to ten.

MUNZIGER ONLINE

offers quick and continually updated, citable information about internationally important people and pop musicians as well as extensive country portraits. You can comfortably research and use the information in the internet through the library catalogue.



BROCKHAUS ENZYKLOPÄDIE ONLINE

is the most comprehensive lexical inventory in the German-speaking world. Supported by experts, it offers citable information in many topic areas. The articles are prepared with image, audio, and video files as well as numerous interactive graphics, maps, and tables, and are continually updated.

What does our service cost?

Library card / replacement card:

- Adults 2.50 Euro
- Children and adolescents under 16 years 1.00 Euro

Library card, renewal fee per year:

- Adults 2.50 Euro
- Children and adolescents under 16 years free

Special usage fees for exceeding the lending period per media / per date of operation:

- Adults 0.30 Euro
- Children and adolescents under 16 years 0.10 Euro

Miscellaneous fees:

- Borrowing with personal ID / without presenting the library card 0.50 Euro
- Reminders if the lending period is exceeded (letter, email, SMS) 0.50 Euro
- Processing a renewal request (written, over the phone, by email) 0.50 Euro
- Reservation 1.00 Euro
- Claim notice 3.50 Euro

Replacements for media:

- Procuring a replacement copy or paying the fair value plus a replacement fee – no more than the value as new

Paying the fee:

Outstanding fees must be paid within four weeks

- in cash in all facilities of the Public Library Oldenburg under presentation of the library card
- by EC card in the Public Library in the PFL
- by transfer, by using the bank connections of the city administration of Oldenburg and disclosing the transaction number and library card number
